WELCOME TO GDAŃSK

Find out more about our host city Gdańsk at www.visitgdansk.com

Gdańsk is a vibrant city with beautiful historic Old Town, full of coffee places, restaurants and bars. If you stay longer or arrive earlier, we invite you to explore it a bit. From this year on you can also use electric city bikes – [Mevo](#).

THE LECH WAŁĘSA AIRPORT

Flights to Gdańsk arrive at the Lech Wałęsa airport, **approx. 15 km from the Gdańsk Główny railway station and 25 min by car** from the city center, the venue and both hotels in which speakers and travel grantees are accommodated: [Mercure](#) and [Ibis](#).

TAXI

TAXI: Typical fare to the city center is around 60 PLN (approx. 15 EUR), there are several taxi operating companies. You can also order an Uber.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

There is a **direct bus** from the airport to Gdańsk Główny railway station and it takes around 30 mins (without traffic!).

Bus number: 210 or N3 (night bus). They go 2x/hour during the day on weekdays. Outside that – 1x/hour.

Railway station (Gdańsk Główny) is walking distance from the conference venue and both hotels - approx. 12 min by walk – please check out the map.

TICKET PRICES

Tickets can be bought in the ticket machine at the bust stop or in the bus.
